Easter Activities

The eggs can be personalised in any way you wish i.e. 'go-faster stripes' or just a name, but any decoration should not hinder or enhance the egg's rolling potential!

The egg rolling finals will also take place on Friday 27 March. Children are welcome to make Easter bonnets at home to bring in to wear during the grand final. The egg decorating, egg rolling and Easter bonnet making activities are all optional.
