Our Homework Showcase is on **Thursday 21st May 2026** and this one is just for the children.

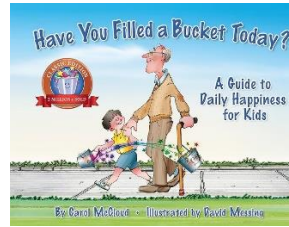
Choose an animal of your choice to describe. Use these websites to help [here](#) and [here](#).
