

Year 6 Newsletter: Summer One 2026

We hope that you have all had a relaxing Easter break. We have a very exciting half term ahead of us, including some History and Art!

Below is an outline of what we will be learning about in the coming weeks.

Literacy: We will begin this half term by continuing our work on holiday persuasion by reading lots of TripAdvisor posts and writing our very own informal travel blogs. We will then move on to reading Greek Myths and responding to the texts in different ways, including completing a first person narrative linked to 'Jason and the Golden Fleece'.

Maths: For our maths lessons this half term, we will be continuing with our work on shape before moving on to looking at perimeter, area, position and direction.

History : Our history will focus on journeys, where the children will learn about important historical journeys and explorations including those made by Sir Walter Raleigh in Tudor times, the Titanic, Kindertransport and the Empire Windrush.

RE: This half term our focus question is 'For Christians, what kind of king is Jesus?'

RSHE: In RSHE we will be discussing Relationships in the Wider World with a focus on communities.

Art: In Art, we will study the work of American painter, Bob Ross, exploring the techniques that he uses. We will then photograph our own landscape compositions in Graves Park and create our own paintings of these.

Computing: In computing, we will continue to focus on programming. The children will recognise and use sequence, repetition, selection and variables to create complex programs.

P4C: Our P4C learning will continue with a range of stimuli to engage the children and make them think more deeply about the world around them.

PE: Indoor PE will be an exciting dance unit, while outdoor PE is cricket. Please make sure your child is wearing appropriate clothing and shoes in order to take part in any sport.
