

Year 3:

Summer Term 2, 2026



We hope you had a relaxing break and are ready for the final half-term of Year 3! We have some interesting units to cover during our remaining weeks. Take a look below:

History: Children will investigate maps to locate City States, focus on the difference between Athens and Sparta, explore what life was like everyday as an Ancient Greek and life as a warrior, learn about the Olympic Games and study Greek art and architecture. We will also have an Ancient Greek Day on **Friday 19th June**. Don't worry... you won't need to prep anything for this as we won't be dressing up and we will provide all the activities.

Science: Children will learn about how animals, including humans, need specific nutrition to help them move and grow, and how humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles to help their bodies move.

Literacy: Within literacy, we will read and respond to a book called 'The Great Kapok Tree.' Children will explore the concepts of habitats, animal rights, and conservation to write an information text. We will also focus on the book, 'A Dark and Stormy Night.' Children will further develop their descriptive writing to produce a story based on the book's framework.

Maths: In maths, we will be finishing our unit on time and then focusing on properties of shape before moving onto statistics.

Textiles: In design and technology, we will be designing and sewing our own bendy bags.

Computing: In computing, we will continue our work on coding by exploring the exciting world of microbits. Children will learn how to programme these to make a variety of outputs.

RE: During our RE lessons, we will be learning how and why people try to make the world a better place.

PE: During our PE lessons, we will be doing fitness indoors and rounders outdoors.

RSHE/P4C: In RSHE, we will continue our work on anti-racism with myth-busting. In P4C, we will explore the concept of creativity.

Reading & Homework: We ask that all children read at least 3 times each week at home, and that their reading diary is signed by an adult and brought into school every **Friday for Phoenixes and each day for Rockstars**. Look out for the homework ideas sheet which will be sent out. Please email photos or videos of homework for showcase in class, ideally no later than the day before the homework showcase.
