Can you work together to draw or make a family tree?	Can you retell the story of The Gingerbread Man? Can you use story language? 	Practise putting on your coat and zipping it up independently ready for autumn and winter!	Find out how your grandparents' homes were different in the past.
Can you make your own gingerbread men by following a recipe? 	Tell us all about the people who live in your house.	Can you go on a bug hunt in your garden or the local park and tell us all about what you have found? 	Practise writing your numbers correctly! Make sure they are facing the correct way and teen numbers have a 1 in front!	Try making and performing your own musical pattern by clapping your hands and stomping your feet.
