### Arrangements for September

We are making some slight alterations to our opening times for September. Gates will continue to open from 8.40am but the **official start time for school will be 8.45am**. Gates will close at 8.50am - which is 5 minutes earlier than this year - and children arriving after 8.50am will be marked as late. Foundation Stage, Y1 and Y2 children will finish at 3.15pm and Y3, Y4, Y5 & Y6 children will finish at 3.20pm. The main points for September are as follows:

- We will open school gates from 8.40 - 8.50am to admit children. With the exception of new Foundation Stage parents, we will be asking parents to drop their child off at the gate.
- Y1 & Y2 children will be admitted via the side gate on Mundella Place.
- Foundation Stage, Y3, Y4 & Y5 children will be admitted through the main gate on Derbyshire Lane.
- Y6 children will be admitted through the gate on the gennel onto the junior yard.
- Foundation Stage children to finish at 3.15pm.
- Y1 & Y2 children to finish at 3.15pm
- Y3, 4, 5 & 6 children to finish at 3.20pm
- Once again, we are asking children to wear PE kit to school on their PE days.
