<p>Our setting:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We have 420 pupils here. • We have 66 staff working here • Our whole school attendance figures last year was 95.79% • 9 pupils were persistently absent last year i.e., less than 85% attendance/ 23 pupils were less than 90%
<p>Our diversity:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The communities our pupils are from are: Slovakia, Russian, Poland, Portugal, India, Turkey, Ukraine • We celebrate the following religions: Christian, Muslim, Roman Catholic, Sikh, Islam, Hindu • We speak the following languages: Punjabi, Urdu, Russian, Spanish, Chinese, English, Portuguese, Italian • 6 of our pupils speak English as an additional language (EAL) • 1 of pupils are a new arrival to the country
