

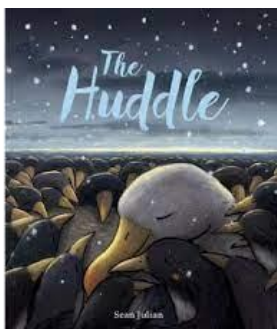

Book Awards

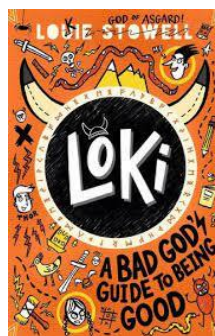
We recently attended the Sheffield Children's Book Awards at the Crucible. The children read the nominated books over the summer term and voted for their favourite. And the winners for each age category were.....



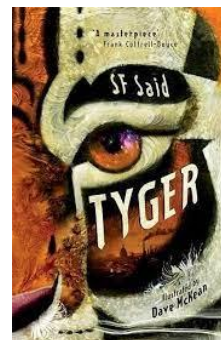
Best picture book
