<p>Can you create your own science book based on sound? You can include questions and interesting facts, quizzes and diagrams. You could include information on how sounds are made, pitch, the effect of distance on sound and soundproofing.</p> 	<p>Rock out on Times Table Rockstars. Can you master all your times tables?</p> 	<p>Make a string instrument to explore how it makes a sound. There are lots of different ones you could make.</p> 	<p>Linking to the Vikings, can you research the clothes they wore? Use a variety of sources to find out about what men, women and children would have typically worn. You could present your work as an information text or a picture with labels.</p> 	<p>Research Viking gods and religious beliefs. You could create a fact file about different Viking gods.</p> 
<p>Create your own maths quiz for a friend to solve. You could include the four operations. Make it more challenging as you go. Include lots of your decimals, time and money learning from this half term.</p> 	<p>Can you use the internet to research lots of information about King Alfred the Great? You could create a fact file about him.</p> 	<p>Can you design and make your own model of a Viking house?</p> 	<p>Create your own model of an ear and label the different parts.</p> 	<p>Research lots of information about the Lindisfarne Raid. Write a recount of it from the perspective of the monks or the Vikings.</p> 
<p>Learn this fun, educational song about the Vikings. Think of the rules of the game and how you could include your knowledge about the Vikings.</p> 	<p>Design and make your own jewellery. This could be a necklace, a bracelet or any other type of jewellery.
