Find out about different jobs that you would like to do when you are older.</p> <p>Create a fact file or PowerPoint presentation about the places of worship for different religions.</p> <p>Create a photo story all about something exciting or new that you have done this half term.</p> <p>Create your own comic strip - you could use the blank comic book on Purple Mash.</p>	<p>Literacy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Practise and learn the Year 5 spellings below. Make the words using letters cut out from newspapers or magazines.• Write your own short story about travelling back in time.• Choose and read a book by an author you haven't read before - then write a book review.• Create a leaflet to persuade someone to visit Sheffield. <p>Numeracy:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Learn the properties of the triangles - isosceles, scalene, right angled and equilateral.• Learn the properties of all 2D shapes - create a poster to show these.• Practise adding and subtracting decimal numbers and multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000!• Practise converting fractions into decimals and percentages.• Can you improve your score on TT Rockstars and get to Rock Hero status?	<p>- Find out all about the Suffragettes and create an information poster.</p> <p>- Create your own protest poster or sign based on the suffragettes.</p> <p>- Present and record your own news report as if you are reporting live from the suffragette protests.</p> <p>- Find out more about the artist Alberto Giacometti.
