### On-line Safety Workshop for parents - Tuesday 14 May 2024

Whether we like it or not, technology and the Internet are firmly fixed in our children's lives. ### Y6 SATs

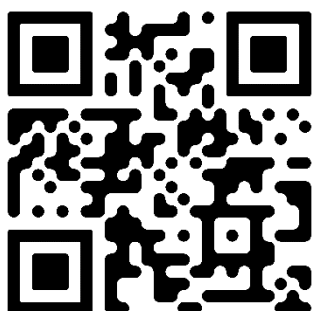
