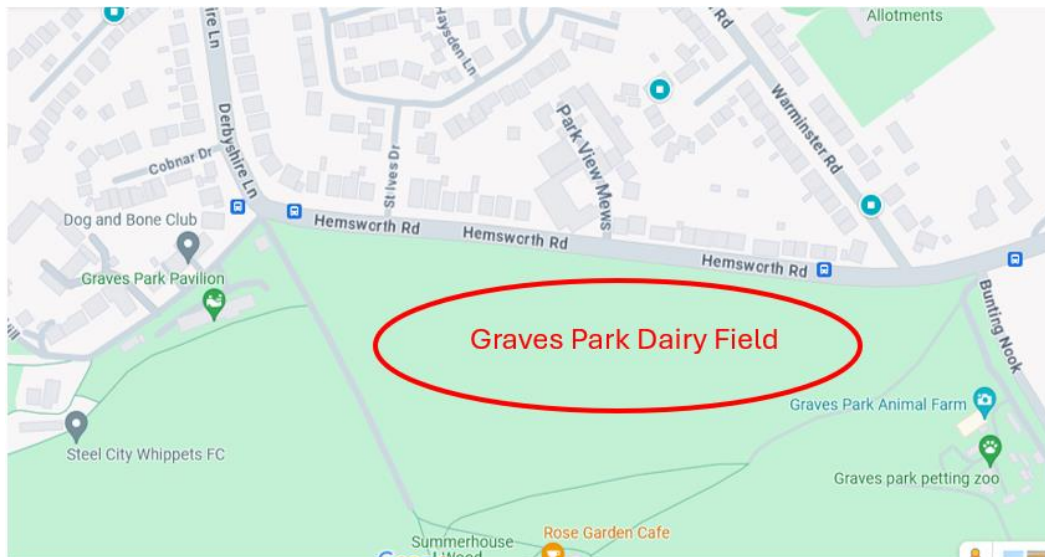
Self Portrait Tea Towels & Coasters
