Can you make an arrangement of up to 5 objects?</p> 	<p>Read a traditional tale with your grown-ups become aware of the way the stories are structured - discuss what happens at the beginning, middle and end.</p> 	<p>Hidden Objects: Hide a certain number of items under a cloth. Add 1 more & ask your child to say how many will there be now. What if I take 2 away? How many will be left?</p> 	<p>Observe the changes in the weather/season. What do you notice on your walk to school? Can you describe the weather every morning using 3 words. Maybe the car has frozen over, why has this happened and what will happen to the ice?</p> 	<p>Write or draw a shopping list! Maybe you could make Gingerbread Men.</p> 
<p>Write/draw a rhyming list:</p> <p>pig cat wig rat dig bat</p>	<p>Make a Christmas decoration for your house</p> 	<p>Practice doing up the buttons on your school shirt, putting your shoes on or fastening the zip on your coat.</p> 	<p>Go on a shape hunt around the house. How many items can you find with 1,3,4 sides?</p> 	<p>Find out about the festival Diwali. How and why do people celebrate it?</p> 
<p>Play catch with your grown up/ a friend. How many steps a part from each other can you take and still catch the ball?</p> 	<p>Practice writing your name, making sure you form your letters correctly. Can you write your full name?</p> 	<p>Practice using a pair of scissors. Can you cut around a circle, square, triangle, rectangle etc?</p> 	<p>Draw your favourite fairy tale character.</p> 	<p>Practice getting dressed independently.</p>
