




# Y1 Homework: Autumn 2

<p>Practise counting in 2, 5 and 10s to 12x the number. E.g. 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24.</p>	<p>Carry out your own science experiment!</p>	<p>Can you retell the story of Owl Babies? Can you use story language?</p> 	<p>Practise tying your laces.</p>	<p>Create a firework/bonfire picture.</p>
<p>Can you write a poem using a rhyming list? Can you record yourself performing a poem?</p>	<p>Make a Christmas card and send it to someone you haven't seen for a while. Can you also make thank you cards ready to send after Christmas?</p>	<p>Use number cards, playing cards, dice etc to generate numbers then draw part whole models to subtract numbers.</p>	<p>Practise writing your numbers correctly! Make sure they are facing the correct way and teen numbers have a 1 in front!</p>	<p>Using instruments or music to create and perform your own Christmas song.</p>
<p>Design a poster about being a good friend.</p>	<p>Collect lots of natural materials and make an autumnal picture.</p>	<p>Practise your handwriting and letters by copying a lowercase alphabet.</p> 	<p>Write a Christmas list.
