Share stories, look at photo albums and ask questions.</p> 	<p>Draw, paint or collage a map of the UK... can you label the 10 largest cities within the UK?</p> 	<p>Make a list of all the cities within the UK. Can you put them into alphabetical order? Which city is our capital city? Find out as many facts as you can!</p> 	<p>Write a story about a robot who is magnetic! Can you include speech in your writing?</p> 	<p>Create your own jigsaw of all the cities within the UK. Can you complete the jigsaw with your friends and family?</p> 
<p>Create your own addition and subtraction quiz for a friend/family member. Focus on adding and subtracting multiples of 10 and 100!</p> 	<p>Choose a city- can you create a fact file about this city? Research facts on the internet to include.</p> 	<p>Paint a picture of two contrasting mountains within the UK. Can you point out the similarities and differences between the mountains?</p> 	<p>If you do have access to a magnet, collect objects from around the home and see which will stick! Collate your results in a table.  Don't have a magnet? List what objects you THINK will and won't be magnetic around your home.</p> 	<p>Create your own word search on mountains around the world!</p>

Can you begin to master your 4's &amp; 8's?</p> 	<p>Create a new invention! Write a paragraph to explain what your invention is, who it is for and how it works.</p> 	<p>Show off your knowledge!
