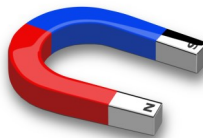


Year 3: Autumn Term 2, 2024



We hope that you have all had a wonderful break and feeling eager for the term ahead. We have lots of engaging units of work for you to get excited about! Take a look at what we will be learning about over the coming weeks.

Geography: This half term we will be focusing on mountains. We will be learning about the features of a mountain and exploring some of the most famous mountains across the planet. We will also look at tourism and the impact of climate change on physical geography.

Science: We will focus on magnets this half term in science. We will identify and understand how magnets work and explore a range of materials that are either magnetic or non-magnetic. Children will learn about south and north pole and how magnetic forces work.

Literacy: Within literacy, we will read and respond to a book called 'Into the Forest'. We will continue our work on prepositions and begin to use fronted adverbials. We will retell the story with detail as well as practising our performing skills. Later in the term, we will focus on 'How the Stars came To Be'. This will include descriptive work building up to poetry inspired by the story.

Maths: In maths, we will be focusing on multiplication and division.

Computing: In computing, we will be learning how we can use ICT to make a poster about healthy eating. This includes inserting and resizing pictures and inserting and editing WordArt.

PE: Indoor PE, we will do gymnastics and outdoor will be hockey. Please ensure that your child comes in a suitable PE kit with suitable footwear on the days that we have PE.

RSHE: As part of our healthy minds curriculum we will be focusing on healthy bodies and diets. We will also discuss healthy relationships online through online safety, exploring how to be a good friend.

RE: During our RE lessons we will be learning what it is like for someone for follow God. They will learn the story of Noah, considering what it was like for him to follow God, making links to the promises that Christians make at a wedding ceremony. We will spend time looking at several texts that share stories from the Old Testament.

Reading & Homework: We ask that all children read at least 3 times each week at home, and that their reading diary is signed by an adult and brought into school every **Friday**. Please remind your child to change their book as and when they need to.

Look out for the homework ideas sheet which will be sent out soon. At least one piece of work needs to be completed and can either be emailed or brought in for 10th December.
